**SOLO REGISTRATION:** To be considered to perform a solo at the concert, directors must return their completed registration forms with all payments by March 1<sup>st</sup>. Selection should be no longer than 5 minutes. A director may submit only one choir for a solo, even if bringing two choirs to the Festival/Conference. The normal allowance for solos at the concert is four, but the final determination of the number of solos and which choirs are to perform will be made by the committee, with priority given to choirs who have not performed a solo previously.
